- SIPVZ targets
- increase accessibility of ICT for schools and for the general public
- support the establishment of information literacy programmes and opportunities for electronic education
- develop information literacy, motivation and confidence in electronic communication
- achieve coordination and cooperation on projects and initiatives

- P Training of intermediate users (choice of 21 elective modules including ICT4ELT)
- S Training of specific skills
