2000 SIPVZ = National Strategy for Information and Communication Technologies in Education programme

- **SIPVZ targets**
- increase accessibility of ICT for schools and for the general public
- support the establishment of information literacy programmes and opportunities for electronic education
- develop information literacy, motivation and confidence in electronic communication
- achieve coordination and cooperation on projects and initiatives

Evaluation - success in achieving the individual targets => using statistical indicators

Target educator groups (groups at which the training is aimed):

Z - Users requiring basic skills

P - Training of intermediate users (choice of 21 elective modules including ICT4ELT)

S - Training of specific skills

N - Training of school computer network administrators

M - Education of school ICT coordinators – methodologists
